### Caution

**DO NOT CART WASH**. Product may be damaged by exposure to the high temperatures.

## Disinfection

Disinfection may be achieved by use of hospital grade chemical disinfectants. This includes up to 10% bleach solution or bleach wipes. Refer to the disinfectant manufacturer's instructions for use.

#### **Equipment Required:**

Disinfectant, water dampened cloth

#### **Disinfectant Instructions:**

- 1. Apply the disinfectant to the product per manufacturer's instructions.
- 2. Let the product stand for the exposure time per the manufacturer's instructions.
- Wipe the product with a water dampened cloth to remove disinfectant residual. (It is recommended that the product be wiped down using a water dampened cloth after disinfection to prevent possible corrosion of the product's materials caused by overexposure to the disinfectant.)

## Cleaning

Cleaning is required only if the product is heavily soiled and standard disinfection is not sufficient. Be sure to follow the detergent manufacturer's instructions for use.

#### **Equipment Required:**

Detergent, soft bristle brush, lint free cloth, running water

#### **Cleaning Instructions:**

- 1. Rinse excess soil from all surfaces
- 2. Apply detergent per manufacturer's instructions. Apply to all surfaces and use the brush to scrub surfaces as required. (Brushing along the material grain will reduce the noticeability of any scratches.)
- 3. Thoroughly rinse all surfaces of residual detergent and soil. See manufacturer's instructions for details.
- 4. Dry with lint free cloth or per manufacturer's instructions.
